## CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Robert E. Morley, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an improved natural spring (Willow Spring) for stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW¼ NW¼ Section 12, T.4N., R.49½E., M.D.B.&M., (Unsurveyed) or at a point from which the SE corner of Section 28, T.5N., R.50E., bears N. 60°28'30" E., a distance of 23,370 feet, situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Helen Fallini Living Trust dated July 8<sup>th</sup>, 1983 & Fallini 1983 Trust dated October 20<sup>th</sup>, 1983, each to an undivided ½ interest

Source: Willow Spring

Manner of use: Stockwater

Amount of appropriation: 0.005 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 150 head of cattle.

Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: February 23, 1982

## Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from Willow Spring, an improved natural spring, where 150 head of cattle water within the NW¼ NW¼ of Section 12, T.4N., R.49½E., M.D.B.&M., being within the Reville Allotment.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
