CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Daniel L. Jacquet, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Buena Suerte Spring #1 and pond for wildlife purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW¼ NW¼ Section 9, T.11N., R.22E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 9 bears N. 39°31' W., a distance of 1,520.80 feet, situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Source:	Buena Suerte Spring #1
Manner of use:	Wildlife
Amount of appropriation:	0.0013 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 200 deer and 100 quail
Period of use:	January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	September 14, 1994

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:


Water is diverted from Buena Suerta Spring #1, an unimproved spring, into a pond where 200 deer and 100 quail water within the NW¼ NW¼ Section 9, T.11N., R.22E., M.D.B. & M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
