CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Floyd and Elaine English, Permittees, have presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Lake Tahoe, through an intake, pump and distribution system for quasi-municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ (lot 2) Section 27, T.14N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of said Section 27 bears S. 83°07' E., a distance of 3,470 feet, situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator:	The Mayne Revocable Living Trust, Dated July 23, 1992
Source:	Lake Tahoe
Manner of use:	Quasi-Municipal
Amount of appropriation:	*0.002 c.f.s., but not to exceed 0.84 acre-feet annually
Period of use:	January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	**June 25, 1921

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from Lake Tahoe by means of an intake structure, equipped with a submersible pump through pipelines to a pressure tank, thence to a single family residence, with landscaping within a portion of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, (Lot 2) Section 27, T.14N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M., being further described as Assessor's Parcel No. 1418-27-210-015, Douglas County, Nevada.

*The point of diversion under Permit 18317, Certificate 5503; Permit 62724, Certificate 16047 Permit 62725, Certificate 17231 is a common intake for water service to four (4) single family residences on four (4) distinct parcels.

**This certificate changes the point of diversion, manner and place of use of a portion of Permit 61784, which changed the place of use of a portion of Permit 55053, which changed the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Permit 6500, Certificate 2078-1, therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 6500, Certificate 2078-1.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
