

THE STATE OF NEVADA**CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

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WHEREAS, James P. Hadden, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Grand Trunk Spring, spring box, pipeline, and trough for stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SE¼ SE¼ Section 30, T.33N., R.39E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of Section 31, T.33N., R.39E., M.D.B.&M., bears S. 35°43' W., a distance of 7,115 feet situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation:	0.0312 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 1,000 head of cattle
Period of use:	January 1st to December 31st of each year

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from Grand Trunk Spring via a spring box through a 2-inch pipeline to a trough where 1,000 head of cattle water within Section 35, T.33N., R.38E., M.D.B.&M, being within the Clear Creek Allotment.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

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
