CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Ron Wenker, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from McCleary Reservoir (JDR0034) for wildlife purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SW¼ NW¼ Section 22, T.44N., R.44E.,
M.D.B.&M. (unsurveyed), or at a point from which the
NW corner of Section 19, T.45N., R.43E., M.D.B.&M.,
bears N. 52°43' W., a distance of 43,480 feet
situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Source: **McCleary Reservoir (JDR0034)**
Manner of use: **Wildlife**
Amount of appropriation: **0.008 c.f.s., or sufficient to water
248 horses**
Period of use: **January 1st to December 31st
of each year**
Date of priority of
appropriation: ***January 11, 1996**

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is impounded in a pit type reservoir with a holding capacity of 3.0 acre-feet, where 248 horses water within the SW¼ NW¼ Section 22, T.44N., R.44E., M.D.B.&M. (unsurveyed); being within the Little Owyhee Allotment and Herd Management Area, Twin Valley pasture.

*The date of priority was established in accordance with NRS 533.395(3) by the cancellation rescission hearing of September 16, 1997.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
