CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Kirk Barton Ledbetter, Permittee, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Lake Tahoe, through an intake, pump and distribution system for quasi-municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

Lot 2 Section 34, T.14N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of said Section 34 bears S. 33°50'05" E., a distance of 3,502.44 feet, situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator:	Kirk B. Ledbetter and Debra K. Ledbetter
Source:	Lake Tahoe
Manner of use:	Quasi-Municipal
Amount of appropriation:	*0.0028 c.f.s., but not to exceed 2.0 acre-feet annually
Period of use:	January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	**June 25, 1921

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from Lake Tahoe by means of an intake structure, equipped with a pump, storage tank and totalizing meter, thence through a distribution system to a single family residence with associated landscaping, located within a portion of Lot 2, Section 34, T.14N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M., being further described as Assessor's Parcel Number 1418-34-201-004, Douglas County, Nevada

*The total combined duty of water under Permit 25923, Certificate 9547 and Permit 66137, Certificate 17259 shall not exceed 2.068 acre-feet annually.


****This certificate changes the point of diversion, manner and place of use of a portion of Permit 61784, which changed the place of use of a portion of Permit 55053, which changed the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Permit 6500, Certificate 2078-1; therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 6500, Certificate 2078-1.**

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
