CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Kenneth C. Briscoe, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well (DeLucchi Lane Well), pump and distribution system for municipal and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE¼ SW¼ Section 31, T.19N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 31 bears N. 27°21'05" W., a distance of 3,067.64 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator:	Truckee Meadows Water Authority
Source:	Underground (DeLucchi Lane Well)
Manner of use:	Municipal and Domestic
Amount of appropriation:	*0.1 c.f.s., but not to exceed 72.4 acre-feet annually
Period of use:	January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	**February 19, 1959

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 323 feet deep, 14-inch diameter casing, equipped with a 60 H.P. Westinghouse motor and Layne & Bowler pump, thence into Truckee Meadows Water Authority's water distribution system.

The overall system ultimately conveys the water to Truckee Meadows Water Authority's water customers within its certified water service area. Said service area is depicted by record (map and legal description) which is filed with the State Engineer's office.

*The total combined rate of diversion and duty of water from the well under Permit 25997, Certificate 8811; Permit 56697, Certificate 17265 and Permit 69289, Certificate 17266 shall not exceed 1.11 c.f.s. and 281.25 acre-feet annually, respectively.

****This certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Permit 17838, Certificate 5365, therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 17838, Certificate 5365.**

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and to the terms and conditions stated in the State Engineer's Order 1161, dated May 16, 2000.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
