CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Robert F. Buckingham, Permittee, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well, pump, generator, pipeline and troughs for stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE¹/₄ NE¹/₄ Section 11, T.42N., R.39E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE¹/₄ corner of said Section 11, bears N. 82°11' W., a distance of 2,110.0 feet situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation:	0.0155 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 500 head of cattle
Period of use:	January 1st to December 31st of each year

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well; 258 feet, 8 inch diameter casing, equipped with a 1 H.P. Kenmore submersible pump and generator, through 300 feet of 1¹/₄" pipeline to two (2) 8'x16' troughs where 500

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
