CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, George G. Lindesmith, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well, pump, and distribution system for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SW¼ NE¼ Section 8, T.22N., R.21E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 8, bears N. 64°35'19" W., a distance of 3,312.50 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use:	January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	**February 28, 1972

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well; 800 feet deep, 16 inch diameter casing, equipped with a 350 H.P. U.S. motor, turbine pump and

totalizing meter, thence through a distribution system for moveable set sprinkler irrigation of 3.50 acres of lawn sod located within a portion of the NW¼ NW¼ Section 9, T.22N., R.21E., M.D.B.&M, being further described as within a portion of Assessor's Parcel Number 077-100-33, Washoe County, Nevada¹.

*The total combined duty of water under Permits 69580, Certificate 17298; Permit 69582, Certificate 17299; Permit 69584, Certificate 17300 and Permit 69586, Certificate 17301 shall not exceed 36.0 acre-feet annually for the irrigation of 9.0 acres. Rotation in use of water from the well under these certificates and the well under Permit 62889, Certificate 17291 and Permit 62890, Certificate 17292 is allowed under NRS 533.075. This authorization may cease upon the approval of any change application(s) on any of the certificates¹.

**This certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Permit 30119, Certificate 10589; which changed the point of diversion of a portion of Permit 28072; Certificate 8629, which changed the point of diversion and place of use of Permit 26588; therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 26588.

¹Rotation in use is allowed for the diversion rate and duty of water between the two (2) points of diversion and anywhere within the described place of use, as approved under this Permit.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre annually from any and/or all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
