

THE STATE OF NEVADA**CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

WHEREAS, Carl Ruschmeyer, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Lake Tahoe, through an intake, pumps and distribution system for quasi-municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

Zephyr Cove Intake

At a point from which the SE corner of Section 9, T.13N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M., bears S. 82°16'19" E., a distance of 2,150.29 feet situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator:	Douglas County
Source:	Lake Tahoe
Manner of use:	Quasi-Municipal
Amount of appropriation:	*0.0845 c.f.s., but not to exceed 26.322 acre-feet annually
Period of use:	January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	**August 30, 1961

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from Lake Tahoe by means of an intake structure through a pipeline, equipped with two Ingersoll Dressler pumps, two 20 H.P. U.S. Motors electric motors and totalizing meter, thence through a distribution system to the Zephyr Cove water system serving approximately 462 residential, 11 commercial and 1 irrigation water customers located within Lot 1 and Lot 2 Section 9, and Lot 2, the SW¼ and a portion of the SW¼ NW¼ Section 10, all in T.13N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M.

*The total combined duty of water under Permit 11855, Certificate 5293; Permit 60910, Certificate 17312; Permit 67026, Certificate 17313 and any certificate issued under Permit 71159 shall not exceed 271.34 acre-feet annually.


**This certificate changes the point of diversion, manner and place of use of a portion of Permit 20061, Certificate 5543; therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 20061, Certificate 5543.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
