**CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

**WHEREAS**, Lynn Forsberg, Permittee, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for commercial (Lone Cedar Station) and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

**SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> Section 19, T.33N., R.58E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 19 bears S. 01°18'11" W., a distance of 1,133.03 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.**

**NOW KNOW YE**, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

**Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 200 feet deep, 6-inch diameter casing, equipped with a 2 H.P. Grundfos submersible pump and totalizing meter, thence through a distribution system for commercial and domestic water service to the Lone Cedar Station / market and one (1) single family residence with associated landscaping.**

**The well under this certificate also supplies water to a lined pond for fire protection purposes, all of which is located**

within a portion of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 19, T.33N., R.58E.,  
M.D.B.&M., being further described as Assessor's Parcel  
Number 007-08B-031, Elko County, Nevada

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit  
and with the understanding that the total annual duty and rate  
of diversion may be exceeded under a condition of a fire  
emergency.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can  
be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the  
use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
