CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Richard J. Baughman, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for quasi-municipal (horse training facility) purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 17, T.23S., R.61E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 17 bears S. 09°33'04" E., a distance of 1,773.18 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Source:	Underground
Manner of use:	Quasi-Municipal (horse training facility)
Amount of appropriation:	*0.0022 c.f.s., but not to exceed 1.0 acre-foot annually
Period of use:	January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	**February 19, 1952

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:


Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 700 feet deep, 8-inch diameter casing, equipped with 5 H.P. submersible pump through a totalizing meter to a 10,000 gallon storage and two (2) pressure tanks, thence through a distribution system for quasi-municipal water service to a horse training and boarding facility, including an office with associated landscaping, located within a portion of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 17, T.23S., R.61E., M.D.B.&M., being further described as Assessor's Parcel Number 191-17-701-008, Clark County, Nevada.

*The total combined duty of water under Revocable Permit 71155, and Permit 74401, Certificate 17380 shall not exceed 3.02 acre-feet annually.

**This Certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of Permit 69325, which changed the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Permit 14468, Certificate 6372, which changed the point of diversion of Permit 14058, therefore the date of priority remains the same as Permit 14058.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
