CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Teresa J. Knutson, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Anderson Spring, an unimproved spring, for wildlife purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 21, T.23N., R.38E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of Section 33, T.24N., R.38E., M.D.B.&M, bears N. 7°23' W., a distance of 19,656 feet situated in Churchill County, State of Nevada

NOW KNOW YE, that the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: **United States of America - U.S.D.I., Bureau of Land Management**

Source: **Anderson Spring**

Manner of use: **Wildlife**

Amount of appropriation: **0.00009 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 3 head of wild horses**

Period of use: **January 1st through December 31st of each year**

Date of priority of appropriation: **September 22, 1992**

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed from the natural discharge of Anderson Spring where three (3) wild horses water within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 21, T.23N., R.38E., M.D.B.&M, being within the Clan Alpine Herd Management Area, NV 310.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
