CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Wallace T Boundy, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SW¹/₄ SE¹/₄ Section 26, T.9N., R.45E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S¹/₄ corner of said section 26 bears S. 16°34'29" W., a distance of 1,136.37 feet situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use:	January 1st to December 31st of each year


Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 98 feet deep, 6-inch diameter casing, equipped with a 5 H.P. Berkely submersible pump and totalizing meter, thence through a distribution system for fixed sprinkler irrigation of 6.18 acres of pasture grass located with a portion of the SW¹/₄ SE¹/₄ Section 26, T.9N., R.45E., M.D.B.&M., being further described as within Assessor's Parcel Numbers 005-581-10, 005-581-11 and 005-581-12, Nye County, Nevada. This well also provides domestic water service for the Belmont Pack Station within the same place of use.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit with the understanding that it is issued as the primary source of irrigation water within the above described place of use; however, portions of this place of use are also covered by the waters of Belmont Spring(s) under Permit 2676, Certificate 336 and Permit 4908, Certificate 518; which are further subject to any Adjudication In the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights in and to the Waters of Belmont Spring(s) and that the total duty of water shall not exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre annually from any and/or all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
