CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, John H. Milton III, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well (Tim DeLong Well No.1), windmill and trough for stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

Within Lot 1 of Section 5, T.34N., R.33E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 5 bears N. 83°57'E., a distance of 933 feet situated in Pershing County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator:	The Tim DeLong Family Trust Agreement
Source:	Underground (Tim DeLong Well No.1)
Manner of use:	Stockwater
Amount of appropriation:	0.0155 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 500 head of cattle
Period of use:	January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	May 30, 2003


Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 200 feet deep, 4-1/2 inch diameter casing, equipped with a windmill to a 16 foot diameter concrete bottom trough, where 500 head of cattle water within Lot 1 of Section 5, T.34N., R.33E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
