**CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

**WHEREAS**, Jon L. Bunch, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for quasi-municipal (Montgomery Pass Maintenance Station) purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

**NE¼ NE¼ Section 5, T.1N., R.33E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 5 bears N. 32°20'22" E., a distance of 683.4 feet situated in Mineral County, State of Nevada.**

**NOW KNOW YE**, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

**Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 420 feet deep, 6-inch diameter casing, equipped with a 2 H.P. Sta-Rite submersible pump, totalizing meter and 1,000 gallon pressure tank, thence through a distribution system for quasi-municipal water service at the Montgomery Pass Maintenance Station located within a portion of the NE¼ NE¼ Section 5, T.1N., R.33E., M.D.B.&M.**
