CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, John H. Milton, III, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Kings River and Tributaries (Log Cabin Creek), storage tank, pump, pipeline and troughs for stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 21, T.47N., R.32E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 21 bears S. 48°45' E., a distance of 791.00 feet situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, that the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation: **0.0309 c.f.s., or sufficient to
water 800 head of cattle**

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:


Water is diverted from Kings River and Tributaries (Log Cabin Creek) into a 10,000 gallon holding tank and pumped through 4 miles of 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " pipeline to eleven (11) troughs where 800 head of cattle water within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 21; N $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 26; Lots 4, 5 and the W $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 27; SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 28; and NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 35, all in T.47N., R.32E., M.D.B.&M., portions of which are on private land and within the Kings Rivers Grazing Allotment.

*This certificate changes the point of diversion, manner and place of use of a portion of Proof V02504, Certificate 373, In the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights in and to the Waters of Kings River and its Tributaries in Humboldt County, Nevada, Case No. 6513, in the Sixth Judicial District Court of the State of Nevada, in and for the County of Humboldt, dated April 11, 1966; therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Proof V02504, Certificate 373.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit, and amends the permit to allow for year round use.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
