

STATE OF NEVADA**CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

WHEREAS, Gregory M. Bilyeu, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from the Carson River (Main) through the Koch Ditch, ditches and laterals for as decreed purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

Koch Ditch from north bank in SE corner SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 33, T.17N., R.22E., M.D.B.&M. situated in Lyon County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from the main branch of the Carson River through the Koch Ditch, thence further diverted through a lift pump and flexible pipeline through a series of ditches and laterals for flood irrigation of alfalfa on the following land:

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the duty of water is as decreed and subject to the continuing jurisdiction of the Federal Water Master.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
