

STATE OF NEVADA**CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

WHEREAS, Javier Goyeneche, Permittee, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well (Goyeneche Well), pump, storage tank and trough for stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 19, T.19N., R.57E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of said Section 19 bears S. 40°15'W., a distance of 615 feet situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator:	The Pete and Rama Paris Family Trust, dated June 2, 2003
Source:	Underground (Goyeneche Well)
Manner of use:	Stockwater
Amount of appropriation:	0.028 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 4,500 head of sheep
Period of use:	October 1st to April 1st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	November 3, 1931

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 140 feet deep, 8-inch diameter casing, equipped with a gas powered pump to a 4,000 gallon storage tank and 120' trough where 4,500 head of sheep water, within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 19, T.19N., R.57E., M.D.B.&M., being within the Newark Grazing Allotment.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
