CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Robert J. Edwards, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Knott Creek and Tributaries, for recreation (minimum pool for Knott Creek Reservoir) purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SE¼ SW¼ Section 8, T.43N., R.28E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S¼ corner of said Section 8 bears N. 89°58'07" E., a distance of 119.0 feet situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Source:	Knott Creek and Tributaries
Manner of use:	Recreation (minimum pool for Knott Creek Reservoir)
Amount of appropriation:	6.28 c.f.s., but not to exceed 500 acre-feet annually.
Period of use:	January 1 st to December 31 st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	*1890

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

No water is diverted from Knott Creek Reservoir under this permit. The water is used in-situ to maintain a minimum pool of 500 acre-feet for recreation purposes in Knott Creek Reservoir from Knott Creek and its Tributaries, located within portions of Sections 5 and 8, T.43N., R.28E., M.D.B.&M.
