## CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Lili Wolf, Permittee, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled artesian well, shutoff valve, pipeline and troughs for stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SE¼ SE¼ Section 21, T.37N., R.53E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of Section 28, T.37N., R.53E., M.D.B.&M., bears S. 38°56'56" W., a distance of 7,810.18 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Date of priority of appropriation:	August 7, 2002

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled artesian well of unknown depth, 6 inch diameter casing equipped with a shutoff valve, thence through 600 feet of 1½-inch pipeline, and gravity fed to two 1,000-gallon troughs where 2,000 head of cattle water within the SE¼ SE¼ and the SW¼ SE¼ Section 21, T.37N., R.53E., M.D.B.&M., being within the Lone Mountain Allotment.

\*The total combined duty of water under Permit 68500, Certificate 16494; Permit 69047, Certificate 16595; Permit 69048, Certificate 16596; Permit 69049, Certificate 16597; Permit 69050, Certificate 16598; Permit 69051, Certificate 16599; Permit 69052, Certificate 17510; Permit 69053, Certificate 16569; Permit 69054, Certificate 16600; Permit 69055, Certificate 16601; and Permit 69056, Certificate 16570 shall not exceed the amount sufficient to water 2,500 head of cattle.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
