

STATE OF NEVADA**CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

WHEREAS, Nancy Boardman, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for quasi-municipal and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 4, T.18N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of said Section 4 bears N. 2°09'50" E., a distance of 1,805.28 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Manner of use:	Quasi-Municipal and Domestic
Amount of appropriation:	*0.026 c.f.s., but not to exceed 1.16 acre-feet annually
Period of use:	January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	**January 4, 1972

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 247 feet deep, 8-inch diameter casing, equipped with a 7½ H.P. Franklin motor, pump and totalizing meter, thence through a distribution system for quasi-municipal and domestic water service at the South Truckee Meadows Wastewater Reclamation Facility, located within a portion of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 4, T.18N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M., being further described as Assessor's Parcel Number 165-011-06, Washoe County, Nevada.


*The total combined duty of water under Permit 30261, Certificate 17533; Permit 48571, Certificate 12006; Permits 48572, 48575, 48581, Certificate 12007; Permit 48584, Certificate 12008; Permit 48585, Certificate 14908; Permits 48586, 49470, 51803, 51804, 51805, 51806, 51947, 52426, Certificate 17534; Permits 52507, 52862, Certificate 13947; Permit 54283, Certificate 14909; Permits 57213, 57334, 57335, 57410, 57411, 57412, 57413, 57414, 57415, 57416, 58325, 58326, 58929, 58930, 59331, 59791, 59792, 61189, 61332, 61333, 61466, 61914, 61977, 61999, 62036, 62237, 62404, 62535, 62859, 63004, 63254, 63255, 63406, 63495, 63603, 64293, 64294, 64376, 64508, 64543, 64987, 65079, 65080, 65081, 65110, 65111, 65185, 65194, 66326, 66327, 67315, 67958, 68052, 68053, 69797, 70273, 71522, 75286, 75287, 75288, 75305, 75306, 75307, 75308, 75309, 75351, 75352, 75527, 75528, 75781, 75782 and 75783 shall not exceed 4947.01 acre-feet annually.

**This certificate changes the point of diversion of a portion of Permit 48578, which changed the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Permit 26464; therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 26464.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
