

**THE STATE OF NEVADA****CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

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**WHEREAS**, Steve Dondero, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Rattlesnake Reservoir #3 for wildlife purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

**NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 3, T.42N., R.57E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the S $\frac{1}{4}$  corner of Section 11, T.42N., R.57E., M.D.B. & M., bears S. 33°38' E., a distance of 8,351 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.**

**Under the provisions of NRS 533.425**, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Date of priority of appropriation:	<b>July 10, 1995</b>

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

**Water is impounded in a natural drainage by an earthen dam, less than 10 feet in height creating Rattlesnake Reservoir #3 with a capacity of 2.1 acre-feet, where 150 deer and 16 antelope water within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 3, T.42N., R.57E., M.D.B. & M.**
