

STATE OF NEVADA**CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

WHEREAS, Karen Dixon, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for quasi-municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 6, T.20S., R.60E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of said Section 6 bears S. 54°34'47" E., a distance of 1,031.36 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Manner of use:	Quasi-Municipal
Amount of appropriation:	*0.0014 c.f.s., but not to exceed 1.0 acre-foot annually
Period of use:	January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	**March 30, 1945

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 510 feet deep, 8-inch diameter casing, equipped with a 5 H.P. Grundfos submersible pump through a totalizing meter to a 11,000 gallon storage, thence through a distribution system for quasi-municipal water service to one (1) single family residence, guest house, pool and associated landscaping located within a portion of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 6, T.20S., R.60E., M.D.B.&M., being further described as Assessor's Parcel Number 138-06-605-008.

***The total combined duty of water that may be diverted from the well under Permit 63185, Certificate 17563, Revocable Permit 63562, and any certificates issued under Permit 74756 and Permit 76386 shall not exceed 11.58 acre-feet annually.**

****This Certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Permit 29893, Certificate 10257, which changed the point of diversion and place of use of Permit 11255, Certificate 3232; therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 11255, Certificate 3232.**

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
