CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Robert E. Morley, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Willow Spring and natural channel for stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 8, T.26N., R.52E., M.D.B.& M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 8 bears S. 67°59'19" W., a distance of 1,013.90 feet, situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use:	January 1st through December 31st of each year

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water flows from Willow Spring, an improved spring discharge area through the natural channel where 320 head of cattle water within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 8, T.26N., R.52E., M.D.B.&M.

Permit No. **39107**

Certificate No. **17589**

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
