

STATE OF NEVADA**CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

WHEREAS, John H. Milton III, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for quasi-municipal (fire station) purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 27, T.34N., R.43E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of said Section 27 bears N. 62°15'11" W., a distance of 1,408.09 feet situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator:	Golconda Fire Protection District
Source:	Underground
Manner of use:	Quasi-Municipal (fire station)
Amount of appropriation:	0.029 c.f.s., but not to exceed 0.74 acre-feet annually
Period of use:	January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	April 25, 2000

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 355 feet deep, 6-inch diameter casing, equipped with a 2 H.P. Goulds submersible pump with Franklin motor, totalizing meter and pressure tank, thence through a distribution system for quasi-municipal water service at the Golconda Fire Protection District's Valmy Fire Station located within portions of the N $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 27, T.34N., R.43E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total duty and rate of diversion may be exceeded under a condition of fire emergency.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
