

STATE OF NEVADA**CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

WHEREAS, Lenard D. Smith, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE¹/₄ NE¹/₄ Section 35, T.4S., R.66E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said section 35 bears N. 57°16'47" E., a distance of 962.11 feet situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation:	*0.103 c.f.s., but not to exceed 75 acre-feet annually
Period of use:	January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	**December 4, 1975

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 190 feet deep, 8-inch diameter casing equipped with a 15 H.P. submersible pump and totalizing meter, thence through a distribution system for sprinkler pivot irrigation of 15.0 acres of alfalfa and grass hay located within a portion of the NE¹/₄ NE¹/₄ Section 35, T.4S., R.66E., M.D.B.&M.

*The water under Permit 72707, Certificate 17625 and Permit 72708, Certificate 17626 is commingled and the total duty shall not exceed 75 acre-feet annually.

**This certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Permit 29834, Certificate 10491, therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 29834.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and covers a portion of the land under a portion of Proof V01076, Decreed, In the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights in and to the Waters of Camp Valley Creek, Eagle Valley Creek, Panaca Big Spring, Clover Valley Wash, Meadow Valley Wash and their Tributaries in Lincoln and Clark Counties, Nevada, dated June 9, 1999 and with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 5.0 acre-feet per acre annually of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
