

STATE OF NEVADA**CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

WHEREAS, George Goodspeed, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for mining and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 10, T.12N., R.21E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of said Section 10 bears N. 8°27'57" E., a distance of 1,541.73 feet situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Manner of use:	Mining and Domestic
Amount of appropriation:	0.056 c.f.s., but not to exceed 0.35 acre-feet annually
Period of use:	January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	August 14, 1989

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 396 feet deep, 8-inch diameter casing, equipped with a 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ H.P. Fairbanks Morse submersible pump and totalizing meter, thence through 600 feet of 3-inch diameter pipeline for mining purposes and 300 feet of 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ -inch diameter pipeline for domestic water service to one (1) mobile home, all located within portions of the N $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, and the S $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 10, T.12N., R.21E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and issued specifically subject to NRS 534.120(2) as a preferred use and with the understanding that the manner of use of water under this certificate is by nature of its activity a temporary use and any application to change the manner of use granted under this certificate will be subject to additional determination and evaluation with respect to the permanent effects on existing rights and the resource within the ground water basin.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
