

STATE OF NEVADA**CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

WHEREAS, George M. Thiel, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from the Truckee River through the Last Chance Ditch for as decreed purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

Last Chance Ditch

SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 14, T.19N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 14, bears N. 24°26' E., a distance of 1,840.0 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Source:	Truckee River via Last Chance Ditch
Manner of use:	As Decreed
Amount of appropriation:	*0.0233 c.f.s., but not to exceed 4.00 acre-feet as decreed

Date of priority of appropriation:	**January 1, 1865

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:


Water is diverted from the Truckee River through the Last Chance Ditch to a concrete intake equipped with a head gate to two (2) settling tanks and pumped through a distribution system for sprinkler irrigation of 1.00 acre, located within a portion of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 1, T.18N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M., being further described as Assessor's Parcel Number 040-930-06, Washoe County, Nevada.

***This certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Claim 208½, Truckee River Final Decree, in United States v. Orr Water Ditch Co., In Equity Docket No. A-3 (D. Nevada 1944), therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Claim 208½.**

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated as decreed from any and/or all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
