

**STATE OF NEVADA****CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

**WHEREAS**, Robert E. Morley, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source via a sump in an excavated pit, pump and distribution system for industrial (aggregate crushing and screening) purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

**Lot 3(N<sup>E</sup>/<sub>4</sub> NW<sup>4</sup>)Section 2, T.32N., R.45E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N<sup>W</sup>/<sub>4</sub> corner of said Section 2 bears N. 42°14'48" E., a distance of 1,142.47 feet situated in Lander County, State of Nevada.**

**Under the provisions of NRS 533.425**, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Source:	<b>Underground (sump in excavated pit)</b>
Manner of use:	<b>Industrial (aggregate crushing and screening)</b>
Amount of appropriation:	<b>2.7 c.f.s., but not to exceed 5.22 acre-feet annually</b>
Period of use:	<b>January 1st to December 31st of each year</b>
Date of priority of appropriation:	<b>March 8, 2004</b>


Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

**Water is diverted from a sump in an excavated pit, approximately 1.45 acres in size, by a portable Multiquip pump, powered by a diesel motor through a totalizing meter, thence through 400 feet of 6-inch diameter pipe where the industrial water is used for crushing, screening, washing and dust control at a sand and gravel pit operation located within Lot 4(NW<sup>4</sup>/<sub>4</sub> NW<sup>4</sup>) and Lot 3(NE<sup>4</sup>/<sub>4</sub> NW<sup>4</sup>) Section 2, T.32N., R.45E., M.D.B.&M. The water is then collected and pumped through a pipeline to a ditch which returns the recycled water to the pit within the above described place of use.**

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that upon cessation of pumping at this place of use, the water under this certificate shall return to the source and no application to change will be allowed.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
