

STATE OF NEVADA**CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

WHEREAS, John H. Milton III, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 19, T.38N., R.37E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of said Section 19 bears S. 66°08'16"W., a distance of 5,703.62 feet situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 600 feet deep, 16-inch diameter casing, equipped with a 100 H.P. U.S. motor, Flow-Serve pump and totalizing meter, thence through a distribution system for pivot sprinkler irrigation of alfalfa on the following land:

*The total combined duty of water that may be pumped from the well under Permit 68730, Certificate 17665 and Permit 68731, Certificate 17666 shall not exceed 270.27 acre-feet annually.

*The water under Permits 29819, Certificate 9778; 29820, Certificate 9779; 29821, Certificate 9780; 29832, Certificate 9784; 30062, Certificate 9785; Permit 68730, Certificate 17665 and Permit 68731 Certificate 17666 is commingled and the total combined duty shall not exceed 1,952 acre-feet annually for the irrigation of 488.00 acres within the above-described place of use.

**This certificate changes the point of diversion of a portion of Permit 29821, Certificate 9780, which changed the point of diversion and place of use of Permit 27496, which changed the point of diversion and place of use of Permit 26032; therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 26032.

¹ The differences between the acreages for Permits 68730 and 68731 and the other five supplemental rights are due to a more accurate current survey used on the cultural map in support of the PBU's under Permits 68730 and 68731. It is the intent of these certificates to be commingled for the irrigation of the same 488.00 acres under all the certificates shown in the above supplemental table.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated annually from any and/or all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
