

**STATE OF NEVADA****CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

**WHEREAS**, Mary A. Crawley, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well (Arrowcreek Well #3), pump and distribution system for municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

**NW¼ NW¼ Section 26, T.18N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N¼ corner of said Section 26 bears N. 81°58'34" E., a distance of 2,293.43 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.**

**Under the provisions of NRS 533.425**, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

**Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 705 feet deep, 14-inch diameter casing, equipped with a 150 H.P. Franklin motor, Berkley submersible pump and totalizing meter, thence through a distribution system for municipal water service to Washoe County's/South Truckee Meadows General Improvement District's (S.T.M.G.I.D.) water customers within the place of use approved under the permit as depicted by record (map and legal description), which is filed in the Office of the State Engineer; otherwise known as the S.T.M.G.I.D.'s Service Area as it existed at the time of the filing of Application 63603.**



\*\*This certificate changes the point of diversion of a portion of Permit 61466, which changed the point of diversion, manner and place of use of Permit 48568, which changed the place of use of Permit 18440, Certificate 7124; therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 18440, Certificate 7124.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
