

STATE OF NEVADA**CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

WHEREAS, Steven R. Hurley, Permittee, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for quasi-municipal (nursery) purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 23, T.22S., R.60E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of said Section 23 bears S. 79°25'37" E., a distance of 1,636.0 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Manner of use:	Quasi-Municipal (nursery)
Amount of appropriation:	*0.0106 c.f.s., but not to exceed 2.0 acre-feet annually
Period of use:	January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	**February 19, 1952

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 600 feet deep, 8-inch diameter casing, equipped with a 5 H.P. Sta-Rite submersible pump, totalizing meter, three (3) storage tanks and various pressure tanks, thence through a distribution system for quasi-municipal water service for sprinkler and drip irrigation of trees, shrubs and other plants, including office facilities, at a commercial wholesale nursery, located within a portion of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 23, T.22S., R.60E., M.D.B.&M., being further described as Assessor's Parcel Number 176-23-401-014, Clark County, Nevada.


*The total combined duty of water under Revocable Permit 65647, Permit 66698, Certificate 17721 and 74235, Certificate 17722 shall not exceed 12.02 acre-feet annually.

**This certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Permit 14468, Certificate 6372, which changed the point of diversion of Permit 14058; therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 14058.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
