

STATE OF NEVADA**CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

WHEREAS, Richard M. Heikka, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Thomas Creek for recreational purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 26, T.18N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of said Section 26, bears N. 71°03'35" W., a distance of 1,710 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from Thomas Creek by a rock and wood dam through an unlined ditch with control box to a pond with two (2) outlet pipes allowing the water to return to Thomas Creek. The pond is located within a portion of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 26, T.18N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M., being further described as within a portion of Assessor's Parcel Number 150-260-08, Washoe County, Nevada.
