CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Sanford A. Shuler, Jr., Permittee, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for quasi-municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 22, T.28S., R.63E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 22 bears S. 26°08'00" E., a distance of 2,377.81 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 750 feet deep, 8-inch diameter casing, equipped with a 15 H.P. submersible pump and two (2) totalizing meters, thence through 840 feet of 3-inch pipe to six (6) storage tanks and further pumped through a distribution system for quasi-municipal water service to twelve (12) housing units which include security housing and a laboratory building with all associated landscaping. Water from the storage tanks also supplies a lined pond used for fire and dust suppression. All water is utilized at Coyote Mines, located within portions of the E $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, SW $\frac{1}{4}$, N $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 22; and within portions of the W $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 23; all in T.28S., R.63E., M.D.B.&M.

A more detailed description of this place of use, including mining claims, is described in the application and is shown on the supporting application map.


*The total combined duty of water from the well under Permit 75683, Certificate 17764 and Permit 75684, Certificate 17765 shall not exceed 19.10 acre-feet annually.

**This certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of Permit 55279, Certificate 13842, which changed the place of use of Permit 49299; therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 49299.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and specifically subject to any current and/or future monitoring and reporting requirements as required by the Office of the State Engineer.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
