

THE STATE OF NEVADA**CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

WHEREAS, David Overcast, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well (Third Well), pump, pipeline, storage tanks and troughs for wildlife purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 27, T.30N., R.55E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the SW corner Section 34 T.30N., R.55E., M.D.B. & M., bears S. 14°31'45" W., a distance of 9,795.73 feet, situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Manner of use:	Wildlife
Amount of appropriation:	0.0003 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 50 deer
Period of use:	January 1st through December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	October 29, 1981

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, approximately 130 feet deep, 6-inch diameter casing, equipped with a Jensen pump through a pipeline to four (4) storage tanks and two troughs, where 50 deer water within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 27, T.30N., R.55E., M.D.B. & M.

Permit No. **44994**

Certificate No. **17767**

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
