## CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

**WHEREAS**, Alan Glaser, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Secret Creek through the Randolph Ditch for as decreed purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

**Randolph Ditch**

**SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 9, T.35N., R.58E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of Section 10, T.35N., R.58E., M.D.B.&M., bears N. 70°10' E., a distance of 6,989 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.**

**Under the provisions of NRS 533.425**, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

**Water is diverted from Secret Creek by means of a dam with control boards to the Randolph Ditch equipped with a control structure, thence through ditches and laterals for flood irrigation of 184.25 acres of harvest, located within Section 4, T.35N., R.58E., M.D.B.&M., as decreed.**

**\*This certificate changes the point of diversion of Proof 00525, In the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights of the Waters of the Humboldt River Stream System and Tributaries, Case No. 2804, Sixth Judicial District Court of Nevada, In and for the County of Humboldt, 1923 - 1938; therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Proof 00525.**

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated per season, as decreed from any and/or all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
