CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Alan Glaser, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Lamoille Creek through Hillside Ditch for as decreed purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

Hillside Ditch

SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 9, T.35N., R.58E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of Section 10, T.35N., R.58E., M.D.B.&M., bears N. 53°22' E., a distance of 6,999 feet, situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from Lamoille Creek by means of a dam with control boards to Hillside Ditch equipped with a control structure, thence through ditches and laterals for flood irrigation of 76.8 acres of harvest and 10.4 acres of diversified pasture, located within the S $\frac{1}{2}$ Section 9; SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 10; SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 14; Sections 15, 22, 23 and 26; NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 27; Sections 34 and 35; all in T.35N., R.58E., M.D.B.&M.; and Sections 2, 3, 10, 15, 21 and 22: all in T.34N., R.58E., M.D.B.&M., as decreed.

*This certificate changes the point of diversion of a portion of Proof 00409, In the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights of the Waters of the Humboldt River Stream System and Tributaries, Case No. 2804, Sixth Judicial District Court of Nevada, In and for the County of Humboldt, 1923 - 1938, therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Proof 00409.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre per season for harvest and 0.75 acre-feet per acre per season for diversified pasture, as decreed from any and/or all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
