CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Linda J. Kelly, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Hercules Mine Spring (an improved spring) through a spring box for wildlife purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 24, T.16N., R.22E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of Section 13 T.16N., R.22E., M.D.B.&M., bears N. 18°47'30" E., a distance of 4,367.64 feet situated in Lyon County, State of Nevada.

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator:	United States of America USDI - Bureau of Land Management
Source:	Hercules Mine Spring
Manner of use:	Wildlife
Amount of appropriation:	0.0033 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 35 deer and 100 wild horses
Period of use:	January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	November 5, 1992

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from Hercules Mine Spring through a spring box and flows down the natural channel where 35 deer and 100 wild horses water within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 24 (unsurveyed), T.16N., R.22E., M.D.B.&M.0 being within the Pinenut Herd Management Area (NV035).

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
