

STATE OF NEVADA**CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

WHEREAS, Robert E. Morley, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 13, T.33N., R.57E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of said Section 13 bears S. 54°02' 38" E., a distance of 1,434.34 feet, situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Manner of use:	Irrigation
Amount of appropriation:	0.198 c.f.s., but not to exceed 27.48 acre-feet annually
Period of use:	January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	August 25, 2000

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 312 feet deep, 8-inch diameter casing, equipped with a 15 H.P. Goulds submersible pump and totalizing meter, thence through a distribution system for flood irrigation for 6.40 acres of pasture located within a portion of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and moveable sprinkler irrigation of 2.76 acres of pasture located within a portion of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ all located within Section 13, T.33N., R.57E., M.D.B.&M., being further described as within a portion of Assessor's Parcel Number 006-52G-001, Elko County, Nevada.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and is totally supplemental to a portion of Permit 1408A04, Certificate 11219 (appropriative flood and surplus surface water from Lamoille Creek) and any use of water under this certificate is allowed only when the surface water allocation under Permit 1408A04, Certificate 11219 is unavailable or reduced and with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed a yearly duty of 3.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and or/all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
