

**THE STATE OF NEVADA****CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

**WHEREAS**, Thomas Allen Wiley, Permittee, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an unnamed spring and excavated pond for stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

**SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 2, T.19N., R.26E., M.D.B.& M., or at a point from which the N $\frac{1}{4}$  corner of said Section 2 bears N. 21°05'43" W., a distance of 2,046.00 feet, situated in Churchill County, State of Nevada.**

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

**Water flows from an unnamed improved spring to an excavated pond, where 100 head of cattle water within the S $\frac{1}{2}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 2, T.19N., R.26E., M.D.B.& M, being within the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Reclamation's Newlands Project livestock grazing permit lands.**

**This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.**

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
