

STATE OF NEVADA**CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

WHEREAS, Richard Lawson, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well, pump and pond for recreational purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SE¹/₄ NE¹/₄ Section 19, T.32N., R.45E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E¹/₄ corner of said Section 19 bears S. 62°50' E., a distance of 518 feet situated in Lander County, State of Nevada.

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Source:	Underground
Manner of use:	Recreational
Amount of appropriation:	0.045 c.f.s., but not to exceed 17.69 acre-feet annually
Period of use:	January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	May 20, 1985


Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 140 feet deep, 8-inch diameter casing, equipped with a 3/4 H.P. Sta-Rite submersible pump and totalizing meter, thence to a pond approximately one (1) acre in surface area near the Battle Mountain High School, located within portions of the SE¹/₄ NE¹/₄ and the NE¹/₄ SE¹/₄ Section 19, T.32N., R.45E., M.D.B.&M., being further described as within a portion of Assessor's Parcel Number 002-190-11, Lander County, Nevada.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
