

STATE OF NEVADA**CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

WHEREAS, Robert E. Morley, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 6, T.33N., R.58E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of said Section 6 bears N. 24°04'29" W., a distance of 1,435.87 feet, situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 500 feet deep, 10-inch diameter casing, equipped with a 10 H.P. Jacuzzi submersible pump and totalizing meter, thence through a distribution system for hand-line sprinkler irrigation of pasture grass and other various grass and tree areas on the following land:



The above described place of use is further described as being within a portion of Assessor's Parcel Number 007-08A-012, Elko County, Nevada.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and is partially supplemental to a portion of Permit 1408A01, Certificate 1372-1 (appropriative flood and surplus surface water from Lamoille Creek). Use of the supplemental water under this certificate is allowed only when the surface water allocation is unavailable or reduced, and with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed a yearly duty of 3.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and or/all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
