

STATE OF NEVADA**CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

WHEREAS, Ramon L. Mathews, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Fort Creek, through a collection box, storage tanks, pipeline and distribution system for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 28, T.5S., R.71E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of said Section 28 bears N. 83°37'45" W., a distance of 1,426 feet situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from Fort Creek by means of a leach pipe to a concrete collection box and piped to a 3,000 gallon storage tank, thence through approximately 2,300 feet of 2-inch PVC pipe, equipped with a totalizing meter for sprinkler, drip and flood irrigation of various grass, tree, garden, orchard, vineyard and other landscaped areas within the following described place of use:

This source and infrastructure also provides domestic water service to one (1) single-family residence located within a portion of the NW¼ SE¼ Section 28, T.5S., R.71E., M.D.B.&M.


*The water under Permit 7508, Certificate 1857, Permit 70286, Certificate 17816 and Permit 70999, Certificate 17818 is commingled and the total combined duty shall not exceed 5.9 acre-feet annually for the irrigation of 1.18 acres within the above-described place of use.

*The total combined duty of water under Permit 7508, Certificate 1857, Permit 70286, Certificate 17816, Permit 70999, Certificate 17818 and any certificate issued under Permit 70285 shall not exceed 215 acre-feet annually.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit with the understanding that the annual duty of water shall not exceed 5.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
