CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, William A. Nisbet, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Gallagher Spring, through spring boxes, pipelines and troughs, for stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW¹/₄ NW¹/₄ Section 31, T.25N., R.51E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the S¹/₄ corner of Section 26, T.25N., R.50E., M.D.B. & M., bears N. 83°13' W., a distance of 8,191 feet, situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Source:	Gallagher Spring
Manner of use:	Stockwater
Amount of appropriation:	0.0045 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 350 head of cattle
Period of use:	January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	July 23, 1979

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:


Water is diverted from Gallagher Spring by two vertical, perforated pipe spring boxes, through 100 feet of buried PVC pipeline to three troughs, where 350 head of cattle water within the NW¹/₄ NW¹/₄ Section 31, T.25N., R.51E., M.D.B. & M., being within the JD Ranch Allotment.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
