

THE STATE OF NEVADA**CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

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WHEREAS, William A. Nisbet, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Tonkin Basin Spring No. 1, an unimproved spring and pond for stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 2, T.23N., R.49E., M.D.B.& M., or at a point from which the N $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of said Section 2 bears N. 49°49' W., a distance of 1,268 feet, situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Manner of use:	Stockwater
Amount of appropriation:	0.0045 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 400 head of cattle
Period of use:	January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	January 11, 1980

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:


The natural discharge from Tonkin Basin Spring No. 1, an unimproved spring, is collected in a pond where 400 head of cattle water within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 2, T.23N., R.49E., M.D.B.& M., being within the JD Ranch Allotment.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
