CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, William A. Nisbet, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Rooster Canyon Springs No. 2, an unimproved spring, and natural channel for stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 21, T.24N., R.49E., M.D.B.& M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 21 bears S. 79°18' W., a distance of 1,340 feet, situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Source:	Rooster Canyon Springs No. 2
Manner of use:	Stockwater
Amount of appropriation:	0.0022 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 400 head of cattle
Period of use:	January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	January 11, 1980

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:


The discharge from Rooster Canyon Springs No. 2, an unimproved spring, flows through a natural channel, where 400 cattle water within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 21, T.24N., R.49E., M.D.B.& M., being within the JD Ranch Allotment.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
