CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, W. Jay Wright, permittee, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well, pump, and trough for stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 15, T.4S., R.61E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 15 bears N. 40°16'30" W., a distance of 4,537.15 feet situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Manner of use:	Stockwater
Amount of appropriation:	0.0031 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 100 head of cattle
Period of use:	January 1 st to December 31 st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	October 10, 2003

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 806 feet deep, 6-inch diameter casing, equipped with a 2 H.P. submersible pump and motor, thence to a single trough where 100 head of cattle water in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 15, T.4S., R.61E., M.D.B.&M., being within the South Hiko Six-Mile Allotment.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
