

THE STATE OF NEVADA**CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

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WHEREAS, Robert E. Morley, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Randy Spring, for stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

Lot 4 Section 1, T.43N., R.62E., M.D.B.& M., or at a point from which the NW corner of Section 6, T.43N., R.63E., M.D.B.& M. bears S. 33°39'36" E., a distance of 474.89 feet, situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from Randy Spring, an improved spring, where 600 head of cattle water within Lot 1 and Lot 4 Section 1, T.43N., R.62E., M.D.B.& M., being within the Hubbard Vineyard Grazing Allotment.

***This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit. The total combined duty of water under Permit 71345, Certificate 17860, Permit 71346, Certificate 71861, shall not exceed that sufficient to water 600 head of cattle.**

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
