CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Donald O. Shullanberger, Permittee, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well, pump and storage tank for stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 25, T.11N., R.31E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of said Section 25, bears N. 29°25'58" W., a distance of 2,692.48 feet situated in Mineral County, State of Nevada.

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 265 feet deep, 6-inch diameter casing equipped with a $\frac{1}{2}$ H.P. Goulds submersible pump and a portable generator, thence piped into a 10,000 gallon storage tank and distributed by a 3,000-gallon water truck to troughs where 150 head of cattle water within T.10 $\frac{1}{2}$ N., R.30E.; T.10 $\frac{1}{2}$ N., R.31E.; T.10N., R.30E.; T.10N., R.31E.; and portions of T.11N., R.29E.; T.11N., R.30E.; T.11N., R.31E.; T.11N., R.32E.; T.10N., R.32E.; T.10N., R.33E.; T.9N., R.30E.; T.9N., R.31E.; T.9N., R.32E.; and T.9N., R.33E. M.D.B.&M., being within the Gillis Mountain Grazing Allotment.

***This Certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Permit 55222, Certificate 13997, therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 55222, Certificate 13997.**

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
